**FMC UPDATE**

Dana Thompson reviewed recent activities at the FMC plant. FMC will award scholarships for graduating seniors from Roy-Hart high school on June 10. Dana interviewed all of the prospective recipients; she said she was very impressed with these young people.

The FMC Neighborhood office will continue to be open on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9 to 4 PM. Debbie Overcamp noted that contact has slowed a bit but there still are regular visits and phone calls from residents.

The May plant Safety Day went well and included a surprise visit from OSHA regarding health monitoring. The OSHA inspector was very impressed with the plant's efforts regarding health and safety. The safety day included electrical safety training conducted by two plant employees. The June safety day will include job safety analysis, confined space training and fire suppression training. A team of one hourly and one salaried employee coordinates safety day planning.

Dana reported that more work has come to the Middleport plant due to the closing of a Florida formulation plant. The plant currently employs 53 permanent and 12 temporary employees.
