Ann Howard opened the meeting at 6:00. The proposed agenda for this meeting included final planning for the plant open house.

OPEN HOUSE

Patt Fagan reviewed final arrangements for the Open House. Christa and Rebecca will do science projects, Ann and Barb will cover the CAP table, Larry Lutz will cook hot dogs. Patt asked for help setting up at 9 AM. The Open house will run 11-2. Plant tours and water treatment plant tours will run on the hour and half hour. The Middleport Police Department and Fire Department are expected to participate.

FMC UPDATE

- ? Bob Wojcik, reported that the Command test runs went well. This included running 6-100 gallon batches of different formulations. Bob indicated that the DEC is concerned about emissions and is requiring carbon filtration to ensure no material is released from the plant. Although the compound is not harmful to humans, it will prevent photosynthesis in plants and turns and turn them white. This was addressed in the past when Command was previous produced in Middleport.
- ? Patt Fagan reported that the work plan for the Phase II remediation work along the railroad property was approved by the agencies. Due to the late approval date, construction will be postponed until spring 2007.
- ? Mayor Maedl has arranged for a meeting with FMC and the agencies and has invited the MRAG and the CAP. The meeting is scheduled for 7PM.
